

Vatika Business Centre raises capacity by 30 pc in three cities

VATIKA Business Centre, one of the largest Indian Business Centre providers, has augmented its capacity by 30 per cent across three cities. With opening of three new centres, with over 65,000 sq ft of fully furnished office space and around 750 more seats, Vatika Business Centre, a unit of Vatika Hotels, aims at providing instant solutions to various business needs.

The company also unveiled the findings of a study on "What constitutes a great office?", which showcased that great location and ease of increasing capacity were the two main concerns of an entrepreneur while opening office in a new city.

VBC already has eight centres pan-India covering more than 2 lakh sq ft of



space for fully furnished shared offices, meeting rooms and virtual offices. Amongst the new centres, the sector-62, Noida centre occupies 21,500 sq ft area, the Hyderabad centre at High Tech City covers 24,000 sq ft of prime commercial while the Business Centre at Connaught Place, New Delhi is spread in 20,000 sq ft.

"Vatika Group envisages opening between five to seven new business centres every year. For the same, we are securing an investment of around Rs 200 crore to touch an annual turnover of around Rs 250 crore within 5 years," Vatika Group official said.
